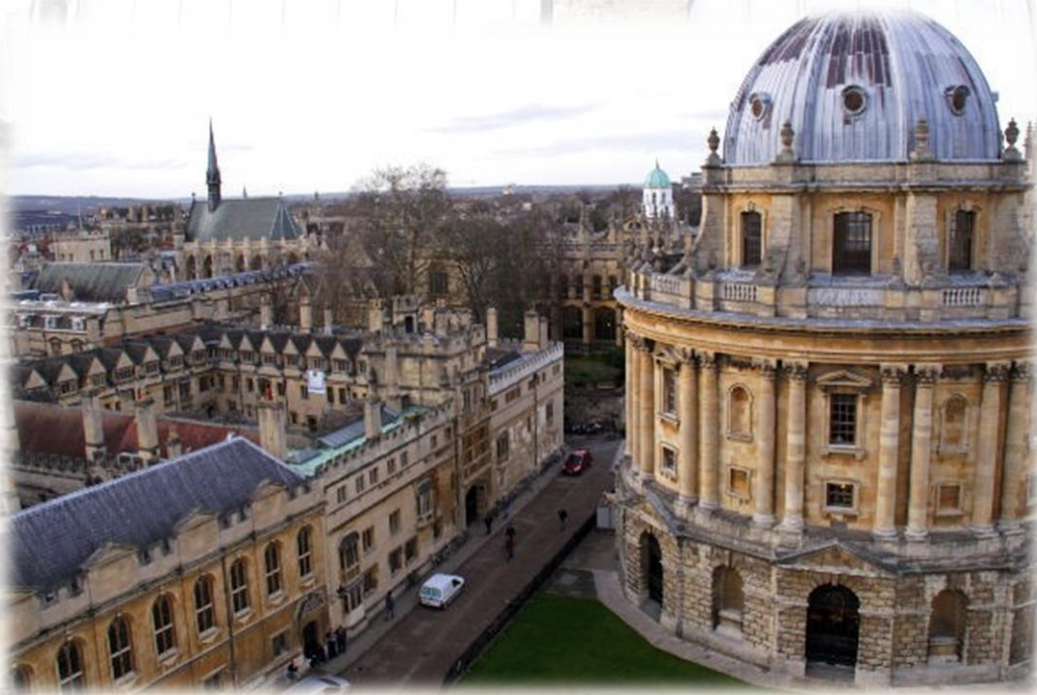


Welcome to Oxford ILS Junior School 2017

Oxford ILS Junior Summer School is a 2-week programme for students aged 14 - 17 years old. The programme consists of English classes in the morning and a cultural and social programme in the afternoon and evenings.

If you want to improve your English and have a memorable experience in the beautiful city of Oxford, then this programme is for you!

Location

Our Junior Summer School is located in the centre of Oxford, in the exclusive Jericho area. The secure entry into the building ensures that students are safe while on the School's premises. The classrooms are light, modern and spacious. There is a recreational room on the ground floor, a kitchen and a patio where the students can relax during their breaks.

Lessons and activities

The lessons are energetic and fun. They focus on language development, individual and team projects, and communication. In the afternoon and evenings our students have organized cultural and recreational activities during which they can put their English in practice as well as learn about Oxford and England.

Accommodation

All our students under the age of 18 will stay with a local English speaking family in Oxford, not too far from the School. Students will typically have a single room with a study desk. Twin rooms are available on special request (e.g. for siblings).

Each Homestay provider is selected to a high standard, they are welcoming and happy to host our students. Staying with a Homestay provider extends the learning experience after the School closes, as students will learn about living in Britain and British culture.

Safety and welfare

Oxford ILS has comprehensive welfare policies and procedures and dedicated staff to create a comfortable and supportive environment for our young students. All staff, including homestay providers, are friendly, approachable, DBS checked and safeguarding trained.

Arrival

To ensure a smooth transition from Oxford arrival to accommodation placement, groups of 5 or more arriving at an Oxford meeting point are greeted by a staff member of Oxford ILS. Students are then met and collected by their homestay host.

On the first day at School students receive a welcome pack and an induction to include: information about the School, Oxford, welfare and safety and emergency procedures.
